The Myriad Gardens Foundation is looking for an enthusiastic individual to join our Public Events team for this year's fall festival, Pumpkinville. Pumpkinville is our fundraiser and membership drive for the Myriad Gardens, a 501 (c)(3) non-profit organization. This is a 17 day event with over 16,000 pumpkins. The Public Events Seasonal Employee should be passionate about events, the vibrant Oklahoma City community, and offering the best experience to every guest at the Myriad Gardens.

The Public Events Seasonal Employee serves as ambassador at large for Myriad Gardens Foundation, and must demonstrate professional excellence and perform to the Gardens' standards of quality at all times.

The Public Events Seasonal Employee will be asked to attend trainings and staff orientation on Wednesday, September 20 from 3 p.m.-5 p.m. Pumpkinville runs Friday, October 6 to Sunday, October 22 from 10 a.m.-5 p.m.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Ensuring a wonderful guest experience during Pumpkinville.
- Assist with sales, admissions, and clean-up for Pumpkinville, pumpkin patch, and Paint-A-Pumpkin areas.
- Performs other duties as may be assigned including providing office and event/program assistance in other related departments at the Gardens.

The employee will work in a botanical gardens environment. Some locations visited during the course of executing job duties may not be wheelchair accessible; most time will be spent outside in various weather conditions.
