- Scarecrows can be made with a wide range of materials as long as the final piece is weatherproof and there are no sharp edges (i.e. it's safe) and **no perishable items (e.g. carved pumpkin heads)**.

- Scarecrows should be approximately human size or larger – between ~5ft – 8ft.
- Provide **two 3"X5" cards listing your name, phone, e-mail, and scarecrow title** to Myriad Garden Staff when dropping off your scarecrow.
- If you are an artist applying, please attach a brief description of your level of art experience or attach a resume.
- **You will rank your choices for scarecrows on the following page and will be assigned one by the selection notification date. We will work to ensure you are assigned one of your top 5 choices.**

Applications Due: no later than 5pm, Monday, September 18.

Selection Notification: Awardees will be notified at email given above on September 20.

Drop-Off Date and details: Selected entries must be delivered to the Gardens by **Monday, October 2** before 5pm. Provide two 3"X5" cards listing your name, phone, e-mail, and title to Myriad Garden Staff when dropping off your scarecrow. All scarecrows become property of Myriad Gardens Foundation.
